- Who is your favourite character and why?

- What are the advantages or disadvantages of Batter Royale being a comic book rather than a novel?
- The characters in *Batter Royale* have big dreams. For Rose and Fred, answer the following questions:
 - What does the character want?
 - What is standing in their way?
 - How will winning the competition help them?
 - What does s/he learn?
- Nicole is painted as a villain, but she has her own reasons for wanting to win the competition. Write a diary entry from Nicole's point of view demonstrating her reasons for wanting to win the competition. It could be a diary entry from:

- What is your favourite restaurant/take away. What do you like about it?
