The Topp Twins are the folk-singing, twin-sister comedy duo of entertainers Jools and Lynda Topp. They are known for their country music influenced style, live shows and television performances. This is the latest addition to their growing collection of picture book and CD sets for Scholastic NZ, following on from *Dingle-Dangle Scarecrow*, *The Farmer in the Dell*, *She'll Be Coming Round the Mountain*, *Do Your Ears Hang Low?* and *There's a Hole in My Bucket*.

Jenny Cooper is the prolific illustrator of many well-known picture books, including these highly popular Topp Twins picture book and CD collaborations. Jenny has received multiple Storylines Notable Book awards, has twice been nominated for the Russell Clark Award for illustration, and won Best Picture Book at the 2015 New Zealand Children's Book Awards. In 2015 Jenny was the Mallinson Rendel Illustrators Award recipient. Her latest title with Scholastic NZ is *Rasmus* (Elizabeth Pulford). She lives in Christchurch.
